

HDTV EXPANSION IN SWEDEN

BROADCASTING OF HDTV in the Swedish terrestrial network began in the latter part of 2010. Teracom's goal for DVB-T2 (HDTV) coverage is to reach about 95 per cent of Swedish households by the end of 2011.

The final target of about 98 per cent household penetration will be reached in 2012. In order to reach this goal and to be able to offer more channels, Teracom is expanding its terrestrial network of nearly 170 transmitter sites in Sweden, with two additional multiplexes for a total of seven broadcasting networks.

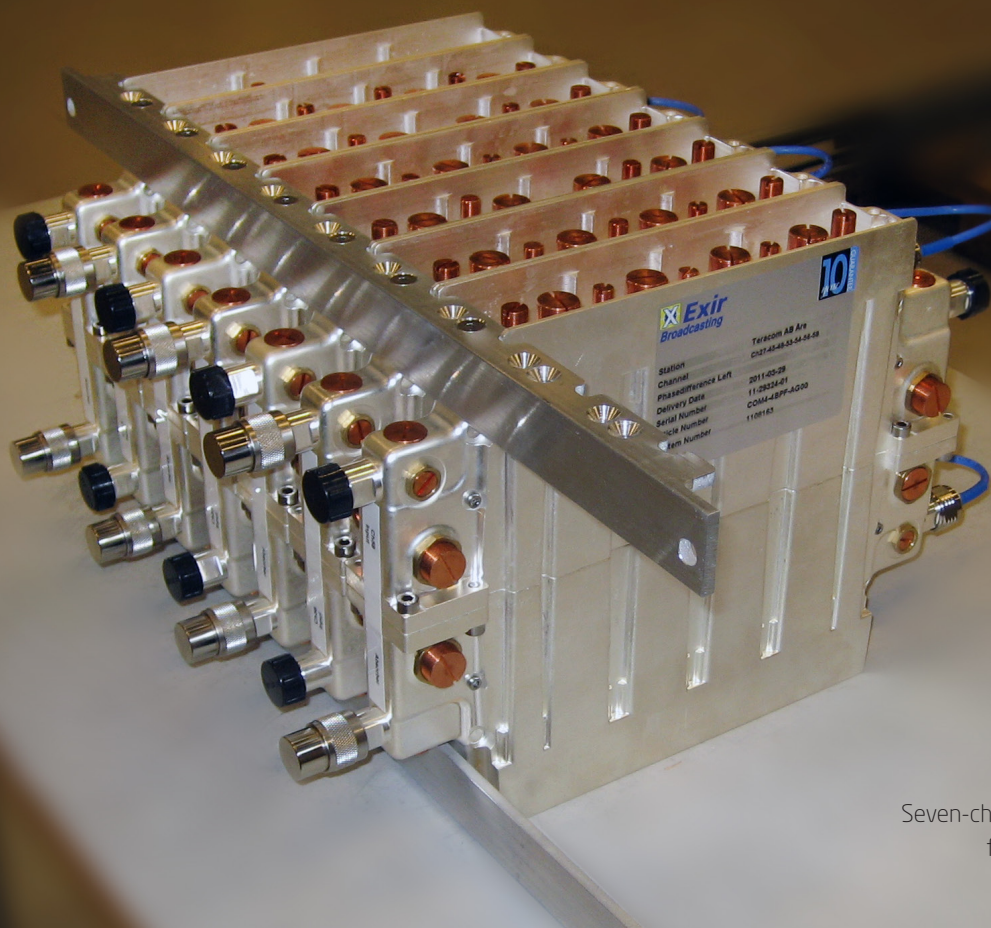
